ALTHOUGH THIS RESIDENCE IS LOCATED in a beautiful, upscale Boston suburb, the home needed some improving. This fact forced the homeowners, a young family, to choose between remodeling or relocating. This kitchen creation is part of that bigger picture, which also included the construction of a new bathroom.

Cherry cabinetry adds an element of sophisticated warmth, and the built-in hutch with glass fronts adds a touch of style, as well as much-needed storage.
